Sharing Science communications workshops provide scientists with the skills and confidence to disseminate their work and its value to broad audiences. Workshops can focus exclusively on working with community groups and other "general public" audiences; they can also address communicating with the media and/or policymakers. Workshops can be virtual or in-person and range from half-day to multi-day offerings.
